1. Please register using the **registration form only**. **Walk-ins the day of the training and phone registrations will not be accepted**. Registration forms may be duplicated.
2. Registrations must be received by the registration deadline date (one week prior to the workshop). **Registrations received after that date may not be accepted**.
3. Registration forms must be mailed or given to a Training staff member or the CCRC Receptionist personally. **Registration forms can NOT be accepted at a workshop. FAXES are not accepted**.
4. If a workshop is at full capacity, you will be placed on the "wait list." You will receive notification of wait list status by mail. If space becomes available, you will receive notification by phone by the day prior to the class.
5. Workshops will begin at their scheduled times. You are expected to arrive on time and stay the duration of the workshop in order to get full credit. **THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED AFTER THE WORKSHOP BEGINS**. No one will be allowed in after the doors are locked without prior approval from a CCRC staff member.
